The Vividha Vidya Pratisthan's Vishnu R. Gauns Memorial Higher Secondary School, is established in June, 1994, with an aim of imparting sound and wholesome education for moral and intellectual development of the students, with a view to enable them to play a constructive role in the personal development and "Nation Building." This Higher Secondary School being located in the most convenient place cater to the needs of the students of Navelim as well as the neighbouring villages with a strong urge to provide personalised approach and attention in imparting the knowledge, which otherwise was diminishing in the Urban Education Centres due to over-crowding.

To meet the growing demand of higher education, the Society established the Higher Secondary School with, Arts & Commerce for Std. XIth and XIIth. The Higher Secondary is being run in its spacious building with excellent facilities.

The Higher Secondary is recognised by the Directorate of Education, Government of Goa and the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.

In accordance with the National Policy of Education, the Society introduced the Vocational Office Management course from the academic year 1995-96, in academic year 2000-2001 commenced Auto Engineering Technology, 2003 - 2004 Health Care Science (Nursing Course) & from the academic year 2005-2006 Science Faculty.

The Management has selected a team of highly qualified, young, competent and experienced staff to guide and train the students.

SCHOOL FUNCTIONING

The school functions in the morning session from 8.00 a.m. to 2.10p.m.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A student seeking admission should obtain a copy of prospectus from the office and fill the prescribed form of admission attached therein. He/she should affix recent copy of passport size photograph and will have to appear for interview before the Principal along with either of the parents or guardian with the following documents.

- a) Admission form duly completed in all respects.
- b) Original statement of marks of S.S.C exam along with a xerox copy duly attested.
- c) Original School Leaving Certificate (shall not be returned back)
- d) Copy of Aadhaar card duly attached
- e) Cast Certificate, (if claiming for reserve seat)

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- a) A student who have passed the S.S.C Exam. of the Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Alto Betim or an equivalent examination of any other recognised Board is eligible for admission to Std. XI. Students passing Std. XI are eligible for admission to Std. XII.
- b) The admissions are valid for a year only and have to be renewed for the subsequent year of study.
- c) The principal reserves the right to refuse admissions to the student whose past academic record and conduct were considered unsatisfactory.
- d) Students having passed S.S.C (Std. X) Exam. or its equivalent Exam. from Board other than Goa Board should necessarily submit Eligibility Certificate issued by the Goa Board.
- e) Admission to any class will be as per the discretion of the principal, subject to the rules of admission.
- f) No admission shall be regarded as duly granted unless it is granted by the authority of the principal, the necessary fee are timely paid and the admission is approved by the Goa Board.
- g) Student applying for other professional courses should inform the Principal in writing at the time of admission and should subsequently submit the proof of admission.
- h) A student will be eligible to appear for examination of Goa Board at the end of the second academic year provided he/she passes Std. XI on the average results of the Exam. held during the first academic year, keeps two terms in the second academic year, completes the prescribed course successfully with required attendance for regular classes, possesses a certificate of having completed the work satisfactorily in Physical Education / N.S.S./ Y.R.C./ E.E./ ICT and attains the required standard in conduct and progress.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION / N.S.S./ YRC / E.E.

The student shall complete and shall attend and participate in the different activities organised including Adult Literacy Classes, Anaul Camps, Social Forestry, Environmental Education activities and Health related Campaning Programme, etc.

GRANTING OF TERMS

Granting of terms will strictly depend upon the fulfillment of the following conditions to the satisfaction of the Principal and other teaching staff members.

- I. Minimum attendance 75% of the days in which lectures are delivered. (Absenting from even a single lecture will be treated as absence for the whole day.)
- II. Regular attendance at Tutorial / Extra Classes / School Function / Days of National Importance is essential.
- III. Good conduct and observance of discipline.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The School attaches great importance to good discipline.
2. Disobedience, misconduct or misbehavior or failure to comply with any rules or instructions issued by the Principal will be severely dealt with.
3. Any misuse of or damage to school property is liable to fine, penalty and recovery.
4. Students are not allowed to use / carry mobile in school campus, if found liable to fine.
5. All students are expected to take proper care of the school property and help in keeping the premises neat & tidy.
6. All students are responsible to the school authorities for behaviour inside / outside the school premises.
7. The students must observe silence in the Hr. Secondary campus particularly in the library, class-room etc.
8. Every student should wear identity card in the Hr. Secondary premises and during Hr. Secondary / Board exams.
9. The students must give due respect to the teachers, other members of the staff and other authorities.
10. The student shall enter the classroom before the long bell given at the commencement of the first period and the end of the recess.
11. Conduct of the student in the classes as well as on the premises of the school shall be such as will cause no disturbance to fellow students or to other classes.
12. Students must not loiter in the Hr. Secondary school premises while the classes are in progress.

13. Every students must appear for every test and / or Examination conducted by the school, otherwise they are not entitled for promotion or filling of forms for Board Examinations.
14. The students should bring a note of absence in school Calender or medical certificate in support of their absence. They will bring their parents / gurardians if informed by the class-counsellors / teachers.
15. Every notice issued and rules framed from time to time by the principal should be strictly followed.
16. In absence of any teacher students should not leave the class-room unless instructed. The students shall accept any alternative arrangement. In no case, the students should be seen in the canteen or ground during free period without permission.
17. Collection of any kind, entry to the visitors, attending classes other than own, organisation of any function / activity etc. are all subjects to principal's permission.
18. The students shall not play Transister, I-Pod, or any type Audio System in the premises.
19. The student of the Science & Vocational Courses shall attend the practicals & any workshop as and when directed and shall wear the prescribed dress (Uniform).
20. The student must contact the school office / library / teachers during the recess or after the last period.
21. If, for any reason, in the opinion of the principal, the continuance of a student is found to be detrimental to the best interest of the school, the principal may ask the student to leave the school without assigning any reason for decision which shall be final.
22. Quarrelsome, disobedient, mischievous students will be made to leave the Hr. Secondary school even if it is in the middle of the year.
23. No personal letters shall be delivered to the students received on the Hr. Secondary school address unless prior permission of the principal is obtained.
24. No person shall be invited to address a school meeting without the permission of the principal.
25. It will be compulsory to all the students to wear complete uniform as prescribed by the school authority.(refer uniform sketch)
26. Disciplinary action and Imposition of Punishment : Student found violating the code of conduct or are found indulging in prohibited activities or any other activities which are considered to be unbecoming of students are liable to disciplinary action by the head of the the Institution.

The punishment may be any of the following as per the gravity of the offence.

Imposition of monetary fine, suspension, expulsion from the school and Rustiction from the School.

LIBRARY

1. The library has a good collection of books, periodicals and newspapers. The students are encouraged to make full use of the library facilities.
2. Students must examine the book on receiving it and report to the librarian of any damage found therein.
3. Books will be issued to the students for a period of seven days. A fine of Rs, 2/- per day per book will be charged if the book(s) is / are not returned within specified time. The fine so collected will be credited to the students Aid Fund
4. Books will not be issued or reading room facility will not be made available without identity card.
5. All books are to be returned before the declaration of annual results.
6. The borrower will have to pay double the amount of the price of the book in case of loss or damage.

SUGGESTIONS / INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS / GUARDIANS

1. He / she should come personally with the ward for admission.
2. He/ she should encourage ward to participate in co curricular activities.
3. He / she should keep a close watch on the behaviour and study habits of ward.
4. He / she should see the progress card and sign the same after each exam / test.
5. He / she should attend meeting of Parent Teacher's Association/ open day.
6. Problems if any, may be discussed personally with the principal.

THE GYMKHANA

It organises sports and games and coaches students in inter-class and inter school sports events. It provides facilities for different indoor and outdoor games. The timing shall be beyond the regular instructional hours as notified from time to time. No student shall be allowed during their instructional hours.

TRANSPORT FACILITY

The Transport facility is available for the students from Sanquelim Bus Stand to School and from Usgao to School. (Route may change according to the student Strength)

CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Encouragement is given for the students to participate in various debates, camps, quiz, wall papers, cultural and other activities organised either by the school or outside the institution.

STUDENTS' COUNCIL

It gives opportunity to the students to develop leadership qualities and to train them in democratic procedures.

Each non-practical subject will have MidTerm Test of 20 marks and FirstTerm examination of 80 marks along with Assignment of 10 marks in the First Term. And Second-Term examination of 80 marks along with Project of 10 marks in the Second Term.

Science subject will have MidTerm Test of 20 marks and FirstTerm examination of 55 marks along with practical examination of 20 marks and theory based assignment of 10 marks in the First Term. And Second-Term Examination of 55 marks along with practical examination of 20 marks and practical based project of 20 marks in the Second Term.

1. Mid - term test will be of 1 hour duration. First Term and SecondTerm Exam will be of 2 ½ hours duration.
2. Core content of 20 percent from First Term shall be included in the Second term examination.
3. Coverage of year's portion to be 55 percent in the first term and 45 percent in the second term.
4. Project work in the second term will be allotted and evaluated group-wise. It should be activity based and promote teamwork. In case of languages, testing in orals should be used to enhance communication skills.
5. Assignment during First Term shall be assessed individually on the topic assigned to the student. Assignment should encourage the student to do reference work making use of the library facilities

The following Nine-point scale for Absolute Grading shall be used in all subjects, both academic as well as School Assessment subjects

Grades are to be awarded separately for Theory and Year Round Assessment (YRA) components, and overall after adding theory and YRA components based on the percentage scored as shown above.

To pass a subject, a student will have to secure any grade from A to G in that subject provided he/she secures minimum H grade separately in Theory and Year Round Assessment.

Theory : Mid term test and First & Second/Final Terminal Examinations.

Year Round Work : Orals, Practicals, assignments/projects. A student who secures 'I' grade either in Theory or Year Round Assessment separately in a subject will necessarily be awarded 'I' grade overall in that subject. A student for qualifying for next higher class will have to secure a grade from A to G grade in all six subjects.

A student failing to secure A to G grade in the School Assessment Subject/s will be given enough opportunity by the Head of the Institution to improve his/her grade in such subject/s, before the declaration of Final results.

A student is entitled for maximum twelve condonation marks (out of 1200) for obtaining overall 'G' Grade in one or more subject/s after adding the Theory and YRA components.

A student declared as "Needs Improvement" and securing overall 'H' or 'I' grade in one or two subjects will be eligible to appear for supplementary examination in one/two subjects only, to be conducted not earlier than twenty days after declaration of final results and not later than one week of commencement of next academic year and for which the portion will be the whole year's portion. Student may be exempted from Theory or YRA component for which he/she has qualified. Such students shall be promoted to XII only if they pass the supplementary examination.
